After achieving Life rank:

_____ 1. **Finish requirements** for Eagle rank in handbook (page 446-7)

- Active in troop and patrol for 6 months
- Scout spirit: Live daily life by Scout Oath and Law
- Serve actively for 6 months in position of responsibility
- Complete at least 21 merit badges including required badges
- Complete Service Project (Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Process on back)

_____ 2. **Fill out application.** (Print or type on original)

- Name (first middle and last), address, phone and social security number
- Troop & local No. = Troop 261, Lakeville, Minnesota 55044
- Date of Birth
- Name, address and telephone of references.
- Requirement #6

_____ 3. **Supply list of references** on your application to Mrs. Bakken so she can mail out reference letters.

_____ 4. **Give application to Mrs. Keil** (Advancement Chair) to complete scouting dates, merit badges and position of responsibility you have completed.

_____ 5S. **Scoutmaster Conference:** Call Mr. Ostroot for Scoutmaster conference. Meet with him.
(wear uniform & sash - bring workbook, letter, pictures and signatures)

- **Must be before your 18th birthday!**
- Mr. Ostroot **signs** application.
- Mr. Ostroot **signs** your Workbook at this time also.

_____ 6S. **Troop Committee Board of Review:**

(wear uniform & sash - bring workbook, letter, pictures and signatures)

- Bring application and Workbook to Mrs. Bakken.
- She will be set up Troop Board of Review when all of the reference letters are received.
- Committee Chair signs application.

_____ 7. **Council Verification:** Mrs. Bakken brings application, Workbook and reference letters to Council office for verification which usually takes several weeks. They will send everything to Mrs. Nitti.

_____ 8S. **District Board of Review:**

(wear uniform & sash - bring workbook, letter, pictures and signatures)

- Mrs. Nitti will call you and set up an appointment
- Call Mr. Ostroot, Scoutmaster, and let him know time, date and place of your District Board of Review.
- Your forms will automatically be sent on to the National Office for approval which usually takes about 6 weeks.
- Call Mrs. Bakken with the results of your District Board of Review.

_____ 9. **National BSA Approval:** You should get an announcement in the mail

_____ 10S. **Eagle Court of Honor:**

- You may begin planning your Eagle Court of Honor.
- Request the Eagle Box from Mrs. Bakken. This box has planning notebooks and decorating items to help you with your Eagle Court of Honor.
- At your Eagle Court of Honor you will receive your award.
- Afterward, your nametag will be permanently attached to the Eagle Scout Advancement Chart.
